World Milk Day - June 1st



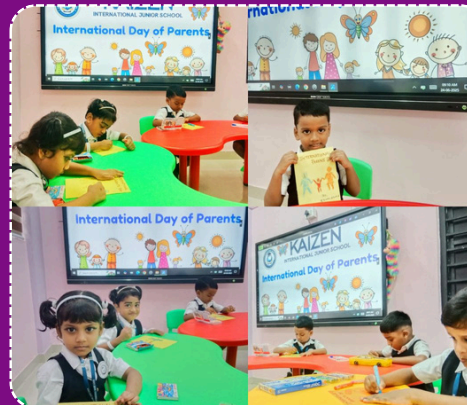

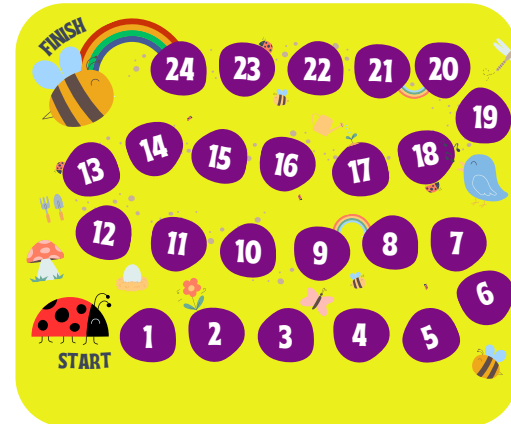
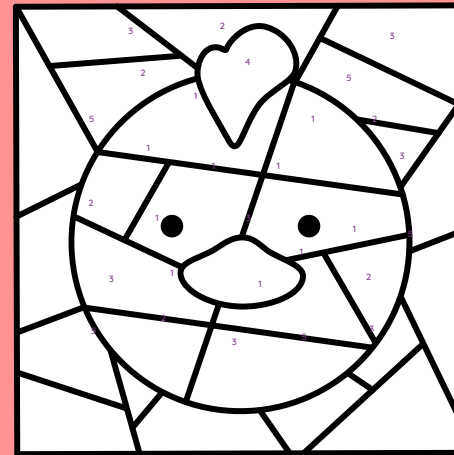
