Engineer's Day- Sep 15th



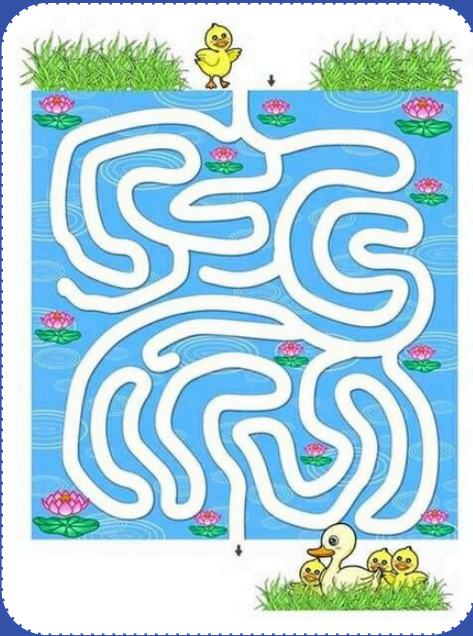

A Panda

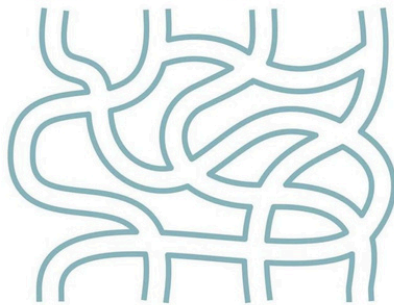
This is a panda.
